It all started with Jim Allsup. Founded in 1984, Allsup began as a one-man company and has grown into an organization of hundreds of professionals.



Through the SSA's Ticket to Work program, individuals can take full advantage of the incentives that are offered and keep their SSDI income and Medicare coverage.
